Abstract: The Vardine Moore Collection consists of rough drafts and other items about Vardine Moore's work from 1951 to 1961.

Historical Notes: Vardine Moore was born in Uniontown, KY in 1906. She lived in Evansville, IN for many years, where her husband worked for Serval. Moore was an active member of the local Tyre Group, the Creative Poetry section of AAUW, Daughter of the American Revolution, and a Sunday School teacher at First Community Church. She graduated from Evansville College (now the University of Evansville) and National College of Education in Evanston, IL. She taught kindergarten at Delaware School and was "Rainbow Story Lady" on WGBF. After teaching, Moore was a librarian from 1953 to 1976, bringing children and poetry together in after-school creative writing classes at Central and McCollough libraries.
