Abstract: The Kanwal P. Singh Collection consists of a memorial sketch about the Lincoln Boyhood National Memorial in Lincoln City, IN from 1974.

Historical Notes: Singh was a native of Jaranwalla, India (in present-day Pakistan). He moved to Indianapolis, IN and lived there from 1967 to 1986. In 1967, Singh joined the Indianapolis Department of Metropolitan Development as Senior Designer, leaving in 1972 to work as an artist.
