**Abstract:** The Arlene Bronstein Collection consists of documents and photographs about Braude family in Silver Lake, IN from 1925.

**Historical Notes:** Arlene Bronstein (nee Braude) was a local businessperson and philanthropist in Evansville, IN. Bronstein attended Ward-Belmont College and Butler University, earning her bachelor's degree in teaching. For several years, Bronstein taught in Warsaw, IN. With her husband, Sol, she was president of Laketon Asphalt Refining, Inc. and Southern Independent Oil and Refining Company, Inc., and served as director of the Southern Independent Producing Company and Trico Pipeline. Bronstein served on numerous organizations such as a life member of the Evansville Museum, National City Bank, Welborn Baptist Hospital Foundation, Mayor's Energy Commission, Public Health Nursing Association, and Evansville Petroleum Club.
