Abstract: The William J. Moutoux Collection consists of books, sheet music, brochures, and other items about business and music from 1881 to 1998.

Historical Notes: William Moutoux was an Evansville businessman and owner of Moutoux, Inc. and a supporter of the University of Southern Indiana. Moutoux served on the USI Foundation board, Historic New Harmony board, New Harmony Society, Evansville Parks Foundation, West Side Nut Club, and many more organizations. He was named a Sagamore of the Wabash by Indiana Governor Robert Orr. His wife, Alda, (nee Schuttler) predeceased him in 1984. Moutoux passed away on July 4, 1997.
