Abstract: The Florence Dale Owen Collection consists of hymnals given to her by her father, Robert Dale Owen, in New Harmony, IN from 1852.

Historical Notes: Florence Dale Owen was born in 1836 in New Harmony, IN, the eldest daughter of Robert Dale Owen and granddaughter of Robert Owen (1771-1858), who bought New Harmony from George Rapp. She married Dr. James Cooper and had one son, Robert Dale Cooper. Owen passed away on March 1, 1863.
