Abstract: The Alleluia Community Collection consists of documents and other items about the Alleluia community in Augusta, Georgia.

Historical Notes: An interdenominational group of committed Christians formed the Alleluia Community in 1973 in August, Georgia, following a local charismatic revival. They live in a complex of old duplex apartments and share their possessions and income. Gradually they expanded their holdings to some 75 buildings, collectively known as Faith Village. Among other endeavors, the community operates a private school, the Alleluia Community School.
