We have fields, orchards, gardens, woods, springs, creeks, a community center, a woodshop, a sauna, a food co-op, family houses, etc. Each family is economically independent; we make/have made our livings in a variety of ways—teaching, construction, woodworking, nursing, doctoring, lawyering, auto repair, sewing, truck driving, small-engine repair, and crafts—and from providing for ourselves more directly through domestic economy and barter.
