Abstract: This collection consists of events flyers, residency policies and a conference paper.

Historical Notes: A group consisting mostly of students at the University of Illinois began living together in Champaign-Urbana in the early 1970's and decided to relocate to a rural setting. They ended up on a 163-acre tract of land in a hollow near Waynesboro, Tennessee, in 1974, where they have lived cooperatively since that time with relatively little turnover. They garden extensively and pursue alternative energy projects, among other activities.
