**Abstract:** The Alternatives Collection consists of newsletters, documents, and other items about the Alternatives community in Bonita Springs, Florida from 1971 to 1992.

**Historical Notes:** Richard Fairfield, born in 1937, took interest in the communal movement. "From 1966-1972, Fairfield edited and published The Modern Utopian, which he founded as a "magazine of social change" that reported on the developing communal movement in the United States. This was the first magazine member of The Underground Press Syndicate (UPS). In 1970, Fairfield visited communes in England, France, Holland, Denmark, Germany, Switzerland, and Japan, and soon after wrote, edited and published several oversized, heavily illustrated books including: Com-munes Europe, Communes Japan, and Communes USA. Penguin published a revised paperback edition of Communes USA in 1972. Richard continued to self-publish books, magazines, and newsletters until the mid-1970s."
