Abstract: The American Friends of Neve Shalom/Wahat al-Salam Collection consists of correspondence, brochures, and other items about the American Friends of Neve Shalom/What al-Salam community in Glendale, California from 2008 to 2013.

Historical Notes: Neve Shalom/Wahat al-Salam (Hebrew and Arabic for Oasis of Peace) is a village founded by Jewish and Palestinian citizens of Israel who live together and seek to work for peace, equality, and understanding. This community of 60 families is located mid-way between Tel Aviv and Jerusalem. It was founded circa 1978 by Father Bruno, an Egyptian Jew who converted to Catholicism.
