**Historical Notes:** Beginning in Milwaukee about 1972 as an evangelical youth ministry, Jesus People USA went on to become a large and enduring Jesus-movement commune. In 1974, the group settled in Chicago and soon bought an old hotel that became its communal home. JPUSA has developed several businesses to support itself and maintains extensive service and evangelistic outreach programs. Its several hundred members continues to live simply from a common treasury.
