Historical Notes: The Mountain Grove community, founded in 1966 near Glendale, Oregon, was a spiritual community whose members had a special interest in the works of Jiddu Krishnamurti. In 1979, they reported 26 members who lived on a 416-acre tract of land that had organic gardens, a community center, and several cabins and tepees.
