I am still in Keesler Field sure don't know how long I will stay here. But I don't care because I know where I am at now, and if I get shipped to some place else I won't know where I will go. Ann I got a good job now. I am working with the 1st Sergeant and a 2<sup>d</sup> Lt. and a Captain I really like the work. I am in the orderly room. I guess you won't know what I am talking about, but any way I think that if I can stay in there I will get a furlough before long, and that is all that I am working for. So I can come home and get to see you. Just one more time then I will be ready to go over sea. That is if I got to go. Ann I got a letter from Martin today and he really had a big time last Sat. nite. Well I sure wish I could of been with you. But maybe you had a better time than if I would of

been there. Ann I am sending you a picture that I took the nite before I went to the hospital you can't tell who is on the picture but the trees you see in back of me. Well my tent was right in there. You can't see the tent but they are really there. Ann the water you see in the picture well there isn't any land any more nothing but water till way out to the Ocean Ann if you want to see some water just come down to Miss. and you can really see it. Ann Martin said that he is in 1A again I sure hate to see <sup>him</sup> go to this damn Army because two is enough out of one family. but if he has to go I sure hope he gets in the Air Corps. Ann I will close for this time with lots of love and kisses

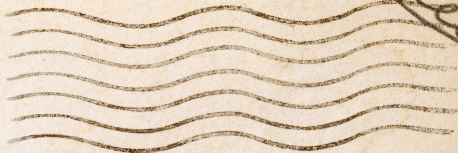
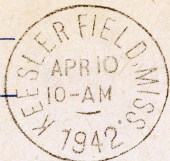
