To day I went down to the beach and layed around for a few hours. Its funny but I still enjoy going down for the day. Usually you burn out on something like that but as yet I havent. It sure will seem funny this winter, going down to swim and knowing you are all having cold weather at home.

The war sure does look good now and I dont see how Hitler can go on many more months. After that it shouldnt be to long before the end. The first of next month I am going to go over to another island in a five day pass. I think I can get a plane ride and that way get a chance to see the islands from the air.

Football season starts here this month and I should get to see some good games as they are quite a few good teams here. What are the prospects of Bosse this year?

The mail seems to be fouled up again although it hasn't been right since the President was here.

We have a show tonight so will close and run up and so it. Fatefully it has been hard to write as nothing new has been happening and what I would like to say, I can't, but I will try and do better.
