Dear June,

As I write here I am ^{about} ~~about~~ to slip down the hill so if you see a vertical pen ~~mark~~ mark down the paper you will know I have fallen. This mountain goes up at about a 70 degree angle and I am $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way up it. In some places it goes practically straight up so I got quite a work out coming up.

We are now in war again and I start this campaign out a little better as I have added another strip to my sleeve. I was made a Sergeant Sunday so in the future address your letters as S.D.J. Parmiter. I will be up so high in a little bit you won't be able to find me. (I mean on the mountain) I am glad to get the raise in rank though as it will mean \$8 a month instead of \$6 which is a nice increase in pay.

I guess you will I think something is wrong hearing from me twice in a few days. Well I wanted to tell you of my advancement and I had already marked the other letter. I guess now I will be able to

write more as I am not a truck driver and
I should have more time to myself. Trying to
hold down two jobs at one time in the army is
not very easy but they have now decided (for the
present) that I am a Technician instead of
a truck driver.
