all this waiting around. In a way,
I hate to think about the long trip
home as I will really be anxious the
last 100 miles or so.

Well, I made Tech Sgt on
my birthday so that was quite
a nice present. I am now making
\$150 a month but I just hope I won't
draw over a couple of more pays.
