We would make bed rolls and didn't get up till about 7 o'clock every morning. The day we had "C" rations we were eating Ham on rye 3 times a day.

What time we have left will be pretty easy as we won't be out in the field. Just the same old routine stuff.

I sure am proud of my ring and want to thank you all again for it.

How is Bob making out in the army by now? I guess he has seen enough K.P. and other details enough not to like it to much. Is he in the flying cadets yet?

By the way, I went up for my first airplane ride last Sunday in one of our Artillery planes & it sure makes no sorry that I didnt get in the flying cadets. I didnt know what a thrill it was to be up over every thing looking down.

I havent heard from you lately, hope you arent sick or anything. It sure is hard to get down to writing letters but I sure am glad to hear from you.
