At a meeting of the Rector, Wardens and Vestry of St. Stephen's Parish, New Harmony, Indiana, held at the residence of Samuel Arthur, on Saturday, the 29th of September, 1849, the Rector took the chair, and declared the vestry to be duly organized;—when, upon motion, Samuel Arthur was re-elected treasurer of said Parish, for the ensuing year, and G. W. Saltzman secretary of the same.

The following Preamble and resolutions were offered and adopted:—viz:—

Whereas, upon representation, it appears that, the late Secretary, Judge W. A. Twigg, refuses to deliver up the book containing the minutes of the vestry;—therefore be it resolved that, such matters as require to be recorded, in the said book of minutes, be for the present inserted in the Church Register of the Parish;—to-wit:—

1. That the treasurer, S. Arthur, duly paid the sum of \$100, out of the funds received for the German Grave-Yard, to the Rev. W. Vaux, and took his receipt for the same,—as per order of the vestry, 1846.
2. That upon the recommendation of the Rt. Rev. Bishop Kemper, the said treasurer also paid to the aforesaid, the balance of the annual receipts of the parish, as per account, to Oct. 1st, 1848.
3. That upon the recommendation of the Convention of the diocese of 1848, the said Treasurer gave a note and mortgage, on certain property, for the sum of \$500, for three years, from Oct. 1st, 1848; and placed the same in the hands of Judge Denny, the treasurer of the diocese.
4. That upon the passage of a Canon, by the Convention of 1849, "for the better government of small Parishes," new Wardens and Vestry were duly appointed, and confirmed by the Bishop in charge, consisting of Samuel Arthur and Lyman D. Stickney, Wardens,—and Thomas Brown, G. W. Saltzman, John Corbyn and Charles Dransfield, Vestrymen of this Parish.



A motion was then made and carried, that the Treasurer present his report for the year ending on the 1st October, 1849, and that the balance of the annual proceeds of the Parish be paid to the Rector.

On motion, resolved to adjourn, to meet again, at the same place, on Monday morning at 7 o'clock.
