INTRODUCTORY.

In recording families, care should be taken that they are arranged in Alphabetical order, and that space should be taken for each family, allowing for any additions to the same which it may be necessary to make.

It is desirable that the Canon requiring a complete Register should, as far as possible, be complied with.

It will be seen that provision is here made for the signatures of Bishops, Clergy and Witnesses, at all ceremonies and functions; a neglect to secure which, on all such occasions, is much to be deplored.

The arrangement provides for the recording of Churchings, now, happily, more frequently performed than formerly, and also for any Private Notes the Clergyman may desire to make.

Each page, however, will clearly explain itself.

HISTORIC NOTES.

*"The birthplace of Western Culture;
the burial place of American Socialism."*



NEW HARMONY, INDIANA, was settled in 1814 by George Rapp, leader of the Harmony Society from Wurtemberg, Germany. Ten years of German perseverance transformed the wilderness into a garden of neatness and beauty, which seemed a vision of promise to the English Communists who afterwards succeeded to the estate.

In 1824 the thirty thousand acres were purchased by Robert Owen, of New Lanark, Scotland, a philanthropist and an enthusiast on the subject of social reform. Here he proceeded to inaugurate the system of co-operative social effort, which he believed would result in "the withdrawal of vice, poverty, and in a degree, misery from the world, and place every individual under circumstances in which he should enjoy more permanent happiness." Associated with Robert Owen were William Maclure, father of American Geology, and founder of Academy of Natural Science, Philadelphia; Thomas Say, pioneer of American Zoology; Madam

Fretageot and Joseph Neef, the first teachers of the Pestalozzian system of education in America; Robert Dale Owen, the author of two of the most important clauses in the State Constitution; Prof. Richard Owen and David Dale Owen, Scientists; and Frances Wright, the first American advocate of Woman's Rights.

This community lived but a year, yet the New Harmony of to-day shows the impress of both the Rappite and the Owen epochs in her social as well as material aspects. The former in her old-fashioned edifices, still scattered about the town, suggesting in the uniformity and arrangement of their structure something of the habits and tastes of the peculiar people who built them. The impress of the Owen period is not found in any physical memorials, but its age of letters has left the place aglow with memorials.

CONVOCATION AT NEW HARMONY.

A most delightful convocation of the Evansville Deanery was held at St. Stephen's Church, New Harmony, Monday and Tuesday, May 5th and 6th. The convocation opened with Choral Evening Prayer, conducted by the Dean, Rev. John E. Sulger, assisted by the Rev. Robert B. B. Foote. In the absence of the appointed speakers the regular program could not be carried out, but Dean Sulger delivered a helpful address on "The Mysteriousness of God's Dealings with Men."

At 7 o'clock Tuesday morning the Holy Communion was administered, Dean Sulger acting as celebrant, assisted by the Rev. Edwin R. Carter. A goodly number of people were present at this early service.

Morning Prayer was sung at 10:30 a. m. The following clergy were present in the chancel and took part in the conducting of the service: Dean Sulger, Dr. John Davis, the Rev. Messrs. Edwin R. Carter and Robert B. B. Foote. The Rev. Edwin R. Carter preached the sermon on "The Secret of Success."

At the close of Morning Prayer convocation met to hear the reports of the work of the Church in the Deanery. Dean Sulger presided, and the Rev. Robert B. B. Foote was appointed Secretary.

Brief reports, chiefly of an encouraging nature, were made by Dr. John Davis for St. Paul's, Evansville; by the Rev. Edwin R. Carter, for Holy Innocent's, Evansville; by the Rev. William Du Hamel, for St. Steph-

en's, New Harmony, and for Mount Vernon, by the Rev. Robert B. B. Foote, for St. Luke's, Terre Haute, and Linton and other mining towns along the Southern Indiana Railroad where there is an opening for work. The Dean reported for St. Stephen's, Terre Haute, and the new work opening up in that city. The Bishop then gave a most encouraging report of the general condition of the Diocese, which is preparing itself more effectively to meet the great responsibility resting upon its clergy and laity to occupy the new fields in its midst which are ripening for the harvests.

At noon Prayers for Missions were said by Dean Sulger. The afternoon was spent in visiting points of interest in and around this historic town of national fame, and enjoying the delightful hospitality of its people.

At 8 p. m. Evening Prayer was sung by the Rector of the Church, the Rev. William Du Hamel. All the clergy present were in the chancel and took some part of the service. The fruits of some of the faithful and earnest work of the rector were seen in a class of eighteen young women presented to the Bishop for Confirmation. Three addresses were delivered in addition to the Bishop's address to those confirmed. Dr. John Davis spoke of "The Responsibility of the Individual to the Parish;" the Rev. Robert B. B. Foote on "The Responsibility of the Parish to the Individual," and the Bishop on "The Mutual Responsibility."

A vote of thanks was extended to the kind people of St. Stephen's for their generous and thoroughly enjoyed hospitality, after which the convocation adjourned sine die.

A pleasant feature of the convocation were the informal social gatherings at the hotel parlor at the close of the evening services, where an opportunity was afforded to the visitors and Church people to become better acquainted with each other.

The clergy present felt sorry for their brethren, who, by their absence from the convocation, had deprived themselves of its helpful stimulus and mutual encouragement. Those who were present voted the time taken from their parochial duties well spent and went back to their respective fields with hearts encouraged and minds refreshed by this meeting with one another.
