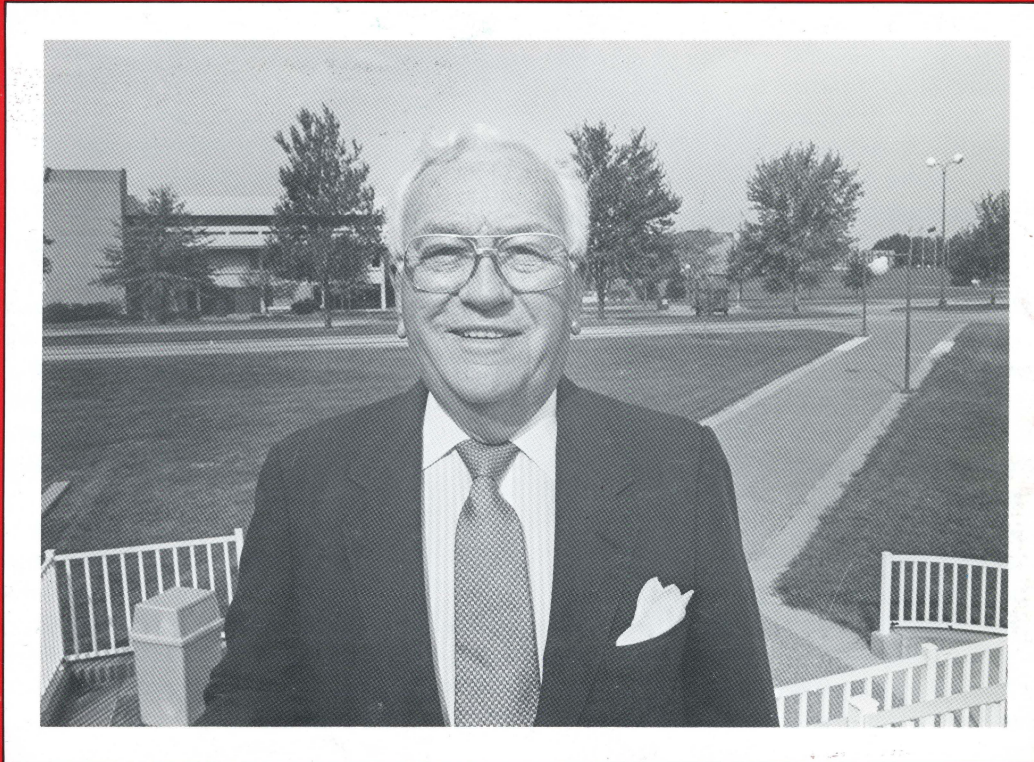

# ANNUAL REPORT

With completion of the transition to the University of Southern Indiana, the University looks to its future with renewed dedication to meeting Indiana's educational challenges. The University seeks to improve the educational level of the southern Indiana region by serving students previously unserved by public educational programs, by attracting greater numbers of minority and older students, and by responding to the needs of business and industry in designing both undergraduate and graduate programs. The University also hopes to contribute to economic development in southern Indiana by working with business and industry in management assessment programs, small business and entrepreneurship programs, and the development of tourism as a major industry across the Interstate 64 corridor. These programs will build upon the excellent instructional programs at the baccalaureate level which have brought the university distinctiveness as an institution which excels in teaching.

The University of Southern Indiana has been given opportunities to participate as an equal partner in state educational circles during its first year of operation. The exchange of information resulting from this participation is invaluable in developing the distinctiveness of the institution. The University appeals to prospective students because of its size, location, tuition structure, the accessible faculty, and housing arrangements. Students attracted by excellence are discovering USI's programs. University programs which are among the best in the state are accounting, art, and pre-medical and science preparation. Evidence of the excellence of these programs may be found in graduate achievements, test scores on CPA examinations, acceptance into prominent graduate schools, and the respect accorded faculty members of these programs.

A record 4,025 students were served by the University of Southern Indiana during its first year and 511 persons were

graduated in the first commencement exercises in May, 1986. In addition to credit-enrolled students, more than 5,000 persons participated in noncredit continuing education activities such as the Computer Literacy Training Center programs for southern Indiana teachers and community service programs for businessmen and women of all ages.

During its first year, USI implemented its first graduate program — a master's degree in industrial management — and an innovative bachelareate program — the Bachelor of General Studies that will serve graduates of two-year vocational-technical programs. The Board of Trustees also approved and forwarded to the Commission for Higher Education for approval two new baccalaureate programs — one in Physical Education and Wellness, the other in Social Work — along with a master's degree program in Health-Related Psychology. An Evansville Graduate Studies Center began operation July 1, 1986, and will work in cooperation with the four other public graduate-level universities in the state and the University of Evansville.

An integrated data base information system is being installed for admissions, financial aids, student records, billing and receiving, financial accounting, personnel, alumni records, and development. A mail-in registration and student billing system is being implemented. This computer system facilitates the collection and use of institutional data.

During the 1985-86 academic year, the University celebrated its first year by initiating the Community of Scholars public lecture series. Six outstanding individuals from the fields of business, biology, law, humanities, history, and engineering technology met with students, faculty, and community members to share their expertise

and knowledge. The University established its first chapter of an all-discipline national honors society with the induction of thirty-six members into the Indiana Iota Chapter of Alpha Chi. Faculty, students, and alumni won numerous awards and recognitions in events spanning the seven academic divisions.

The University stepped up its commitment to economic development in southern Indiana through several activities. A study of the Economic Impact of the University of Southern Indiana on Evansville and Vanderburgh County was completed by the Division of Business. A major new development, a cooperative management arrangement with Historic New Harmony, was implemented this year and the university has assumed a catalyst role in a program to enable communities to capitalize upon tourism opportunities by linking historic sites in Southern Indiana — New Harmony, Corydon, Lincolnland, Angel Mounds, and Vincennes.

The faculty of the institution continue their exemplary record of service to their communities through consulting and research activities for a wide range of community organizations, many of them nonprofit. Business and industry officials have indicated a greater interest in University programs at their site and administrators are working to design specific courses to meet those requests. The number of persons enrolling in computer education courses has increased in the past year, and the demand continues. The University feels its role in helping business, industry, and educational organizations adapt to new technologies is an important service.

Programs also are being developed with private resources to assist students and faculty while contributing to the quality of life in the communities of southern Indiana. Endowments are being established within the USI Foundation, whose assets passed the \$1,000,000 mark this year, to provide scholarships to students in financial need and to those compiling excellent academic records. The endowments also will aid faculty in research projects and professional advancement, and provide the faculty with resources to bring prominent scholars and artists to southern Indiana to share expertise with faculty, students, and community organizations.

The institution is working diligently to improve access to higher education. Recruitment programs are being designed which will remove barriers for minority and older students. Financial-aid capabilities have been increased from \$2.8 million to \$3.3 million during the past year. The staff continues to work with southern Indiana high schools to improve the percentage of students who attend college after high school graduation. Remediation is extended to those students inadequately prepared for college attendance, and younger high school students are being encouraged to choose high school curricula which will enable them to attend college without remediation. Privately-financed nonprofit apartments adjacent to the campus have been an

important addition to enhance access and to retain students. Students from counties with low college attendance rates, such as Perry, Dubois, and Pike counties, now have an option to the three-hour commute each day. Preliminary survey information from housing managers shows a greater retention rate in student housing than the student body at large.

Work opportunities for students are enhanced by a Job Locator program which focuses upon job development for undergraduates. In 1984-85, 151 students took advantage of off-campus placements and earned \$164,000; preliminary figures for 1985-86 indicate that 197 Job Locator-placed students earned a total of \$249,700. The 1985-86 Cooperative Education and Internship placements, serving this same undergraduate population, increased 60 percent over 1984-85. Placement activity for graduates has seen an increase in on-campus recruiting activity and graduates appear to be receiving more job offers sooner than in past years.

Student life programs also continue to improve. A student leadership program and a peer counseling system have been implemented, one new social fraternity and one new social sorority have colonized this year, and student leadership clubs and organizations have expanded. The needs of both commuter and resident students are reflected in all social, recreational, and educational programs. The University's intercollegiate athletic program includes six men's sports and five women's sports. The athletes continue to be positive ambassadors for the university. The University remains competitive in its athletic conference and

several athletes received conference and national recognition, including one USI team member who compiled the highest grade point average of any basketball player in the Great Lakes Valley Conference.

At its May meeting, the Board of Trustees approved a General Fund Operating Budget of \$12,605,000 for Fiscal Year 1986-87. This balanced budget was accomplished with a student fee increase that will permit University of Southern Indiana student fees to remain the lowest of the public four-year universities in Indiana, due in great part to the state appropriation of 69 percent of this budget. The reasonable level of student fees plays a key role in maintaining financial access for students, a matter of key concern to trustees.

One fiscal highlight of the year was the refinancing of the Academic Facilities Bonds, saving the state \$3,140,941 by reducing the debt service requirements on the present academic facilities from \$13,796,926 to \$10,655,984. The 1985 Indiana General Assembly had passed legislation allowing the University of Southern Indiana to use previously required reserves of \$737,000 to reduce the debt and change the pay-off date from 2008 to 2000.

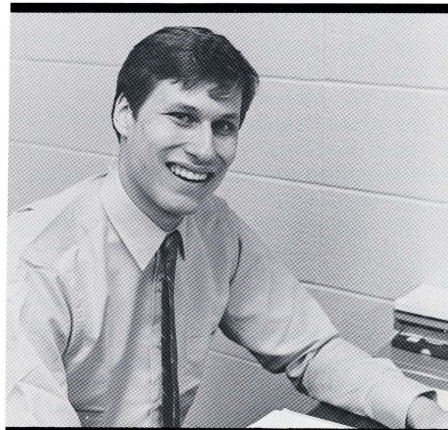

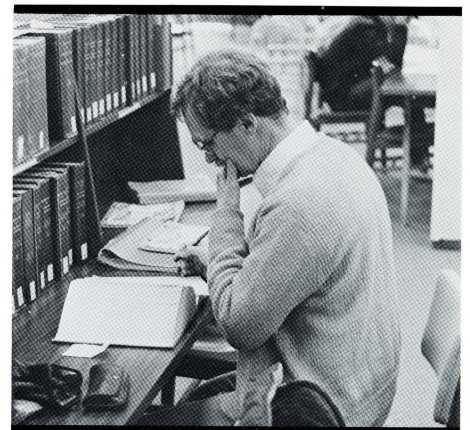

Dr. Joseph E. O'Daniel, a member of the USI Board of Trustees and one of the founders of the university's Foundation was honored October 28 in Washington, D.C., when he was presented the 1986 Volunteer of the Year in higher education award by the Council for the Advancement and Support of Education (CASE).

Dr. O'Daniel had been nominated by University officials for recognition of his many years of dedicated voluntary service on behalf of USI. The award was present at a dinner at the newly renovated Willard Hotel in Washington, also attended by the other USI Board members, University officials, and several members of Dr. O'Daniel's family.

In receiving the award, Dr. O'Daniel said he felt lucky because "a lot of people have made me look good. I'm very flattered, but I must keep uppermost all the wonderful people who have supported me in these activities."

He said the award helps bring national recognition to USI. "I predict that, in the future, they will get to know us better," he said.

Your selflessness and commitment to the welfare of others has persisted over the years, producing such great accomplishments as the founding of the Indiana State University, Evansville, in 1965, which now stands as the University of Southern Indiana.

The award carried a \$2,500 cash price, sponsored by the Ford Motor Company Fund, which Dr. O'Daniel donated to the

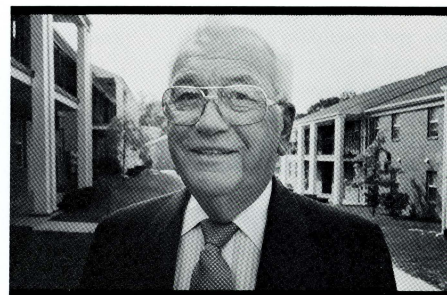
University. It was a gesture indicative of his dedicated support of University needs since he first became a part of the community group that worked to bring a state-supported institution of higher education to Evansville in the early 1960s.

As a founding member of the nonprofit organization, Southern Indiana Higher Education, Inc. (SIHE), Dr. O'Daniel helped raise nearly \$1 million to purchase 1,400 acres of real estate to establish the Mid-American University Center. The Evansville campus of Indiana State University at that time was housed in a condemned elementary school accommodating 412 students. Recognizing that the University needed a proper home, SIHE, donated 300 acres of land to Indiana State University for the Evansville campus and placed the rest in trust for future educational development. Dr. O'Daniel also helped to establish the campus fundraising arm, the USI Foundation, and served as its president for three terms before becoming chairman of the board. Dr. O'Daniel organized fund drives, instituted annual club level giving categories, and helped manage the Foundation's investments for almost ten years.

To ensure the health of the infant campus, Dr. O'Daniel connected it with its lifeline — the students. When gasoline and living costs increased to the level that commuting became too expensive, he saw the need for affordable student housing and began the process of providing it without the use of state funds. Through diligent investigation, he learned SIHE could qualify for low-interest construction funding, found a lending

institution to finance the project, and, in the search for lower interest rates, arranged for the funding through banks in the community. This saved hundreds of thousands of dollars and — the most important aspect to Dr. O'Daniel — reduced the rent the students would pay. Dr. O'Daniel personally supervised development of the Mid-America Student Housing, from hiring the contractors to choosing the shower hooks. SIHE has since expanded student housing by acquiring the nearby Campus Apartments.

Dr. O'Daniel served on the Board of Incorporators for a Separate State University in Southwest Indiana, then became one of the original members of the USI Board of Trustees, where he serves as vice chairman.

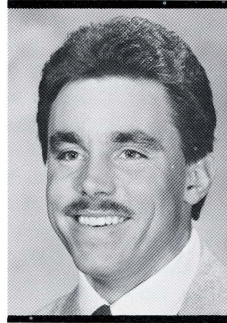

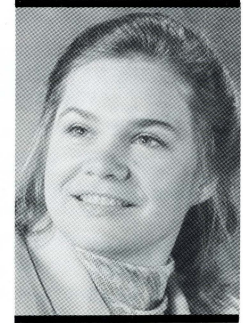

9. Revise Constitution to define legal relationship to University.

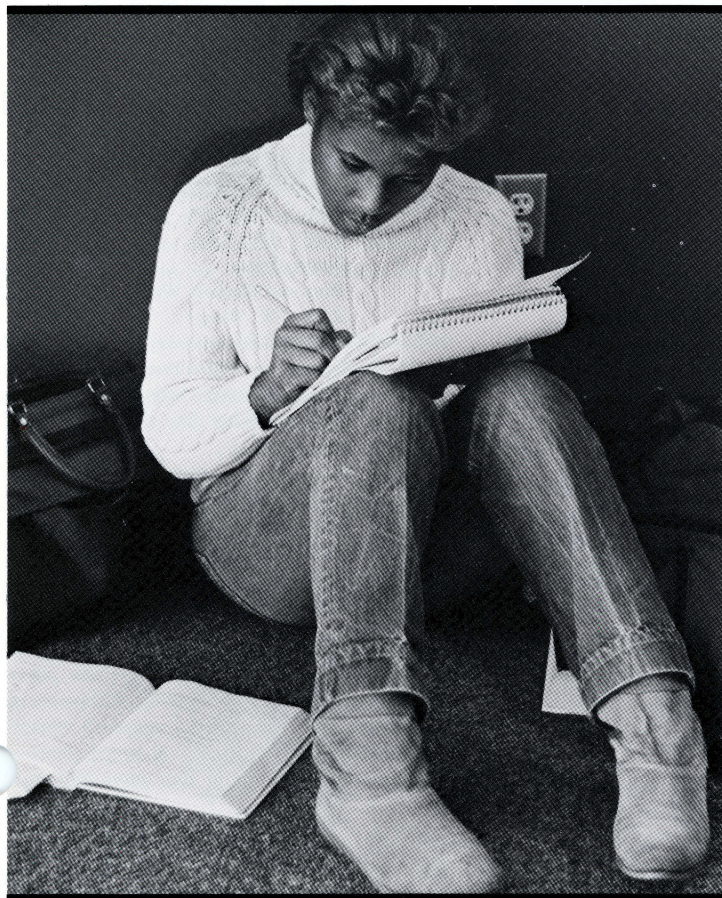

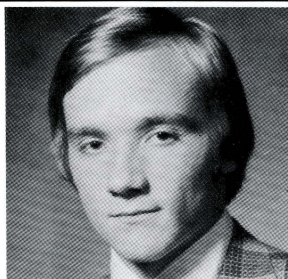
"It is remarkable to think I am serving a role once held by a priest," Whitehouse says. "It has been

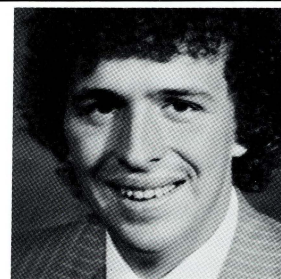
