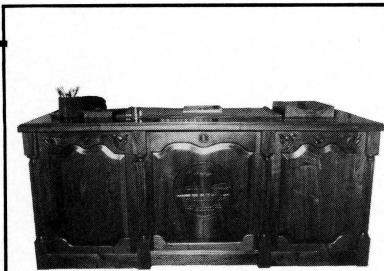
The Alumni Association took the opportunity to award its Past President Award to David A. Bunner, '72, in

recognition of his hard work, dedication, and interest while president in 1982-83 of the ISUE Alumni Association.

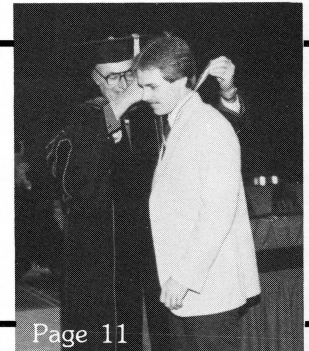

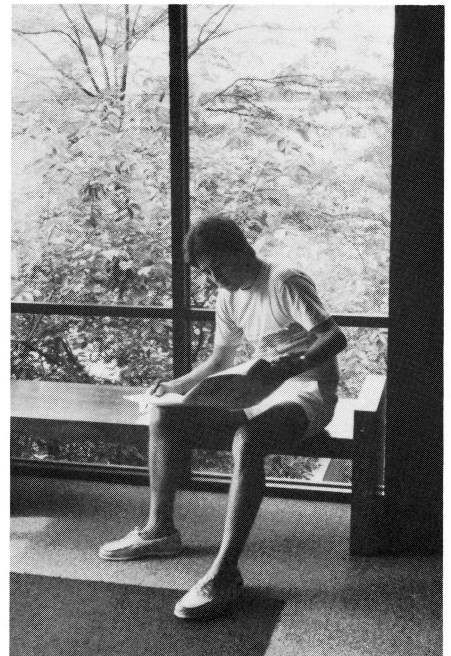

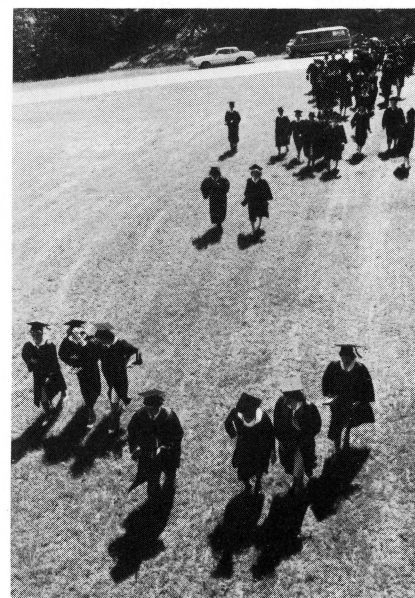

THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

A University president makes daily decisions in his office, but he also makes many late-night decisions at home. ISUE's president sits working and thinking behind an early Chippendale-style desk in his master bedroom, a beautiful and enduring gift designed and built by Jim Myers with wood donated by A. B. Brown.

While the University Home exhibits many antiques and new pieces of furniture, perhaps the most outstanding is the president's desk. Picture yourself touring the University Home. As you approach the master bedroom, the magnificence of the desk pulls you in for a closer look. Standing before the desk, the intricacy of the hand-carved university seal adorning the front of the desk impresses you. How long did it take to carve the seal alone, you wonder. The superb craftsmanship draws you behind the desk for a closer look at the drawers.

There are three beautifully carved drawers on each side of the chair opening. Because each of the six drawer fronts came from the same piece of wood, the grain patterns match exactly. Your eyes scan the desk, taking in the reeded Chippendale-style corner posts, the delicate rosettes, and the panel duplicating a design by an English craftsman. A glint of brass brings your gaze to the Chippendale (1760-1775) drawer pulls made of cast brass. The brilliantly finished desk top, you learn, began as rough walnut, but was planed down to create a flawlessly smooth surface. In awe, you step back to ponder the splendor and elegance of the entire desk.

One of the most respected woodworkers in the tri-state, Jim Myers, built and designed the desk. He learned the craft from his grandfather, Wilbert Etchison, in his day one of the country's top cabinetmakers. As a boy, Myers aspired to a career in business. After college, however, he began an apprenticeship with his uncle and found the

craft a source of real satisfaction. Today, Myers owns and operates the Quality Cupboard Company in Evansville. He doesn't view his work as a job. "I'm one of the few people whose avocation and occupation are the same," he smiles. Sometimes he enjoys it so much he returns to the shop to continue working after hours. Myers explains, "I'm sort of like the postman who

As in past years, ISUE maintains an unusually high acceptance rate of students to medical schools. This year, the rate was 100%. Over the history of the institution, the rate is near 90%.

According to Dr. Melvin Denner, academic advisor of premedical students and chairman of the division of science and mathematics, ISUE students have a high acceptance rate in medical and professional schools because they are well counseled in a strong academic program. The ISUE program requires students to excel not only in the sciences, but in other general studies as well.

NEIL MARTIN, DONALD PITZER HONORED FOR SERVICE TO ISUE

At the University's Honors Day Convocation Indiana State University Evansville's two top awards went to Neil J. Martin, a senior biology major from Boonville, Indiana, and Dr. Donald E. Pitzer, professor of history, who has established an international reputation for his research into communal societies. Martin received the University's first President's Medallion, and Pitzer was chosen Distinguished Professor.

A biology major, Martin is a magna cum laude member of the Class of 1984. He was one of the first applicants to be accepted to the Indiana University School of Medicine, where he will enroll in the fall.

In addition to being named to the National Dean's List, Martin's academic achievements include the ISUE Academic Scholarship, the Academic Achievement Award for Pre-Medicine, the Alcoa Foundation Scholarship and the ISUE Presidential Service Scholarship.

Martin has been involved in many phases of campus and community activities. He was president of Sigma Epsilon Chi Science Club, vice-president of Sigma Zeta National Honor Society, secretary of Lambda Chi Alpha social fraternity, an ISUE Amigo orientation leader, and a member of the Ecology Club. He also has participated in Intramural softball, football and basketball, Spring Week and Greek Week activities, and the Eagle Gran Prix bike

race. Martin volunteered his services for the Special Olympics Track and Field Games, and the "Walk for Joey" muscular dystrophy telethon.

Dr. Pitzer received the Ph.D. in history from Ohio State University, and the M.A. from Pennsylvania State University. He began his education at Wittenberg University and Messiah College. He has taught at Taylor University, Messiah College, and Ohio State. In 1967, he joined the faculty at ISUE. While on sabbatical from ISUE in 1983, Dr. Pitzer was the Scholar-in-Residence at Harvard University, and also prepared and presented the Colston Lecture at the Colston Symposium on Utopias at the University of Bristol in England. He is widely traveled and has lectured in many foreign countries, as well as many of the states.

Among his memberships are the Indiana Historical Society, the National Communal Societies Association, the American Historical Association and the Evansville-Vanderburgh Historical Association.

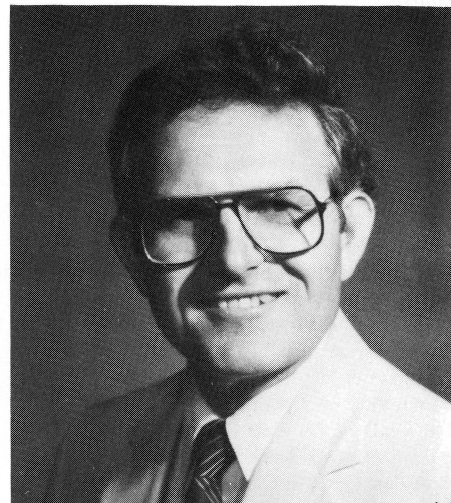
Awards are not new to the Distinguished Professor, who received outstanding professor citations from students in 1972 and again in 1979. He is listed as an Outstanding Educator of America.

The award carries a \$1000 honorarium, which is made possible by a grant from National City Bank of Evansville.

The son of Dr. and Mrs. Noel J. Martin, he was nominated for the Medallion by his professors and chosen by the Faculty Academic Affairs Committee. Dr. Howard Dunn, Professor of chemistry at ISUE, called him "one of the best students" he ever had, and spoke of his personal traits saying he "is courteous, honest, and approaches everything with a professional, mature attitude." Dr. Melvin Denner, chairman of the division of social science, a biology professor and pre-med advisor, cited Martin's integrity. "Neil is a gentleman...the epitome of a professional person..." who "possesses high moral and ethical values, and practices what he believes," he said.

The President's Medallion was

established by the faculty to recognize a graduating senior who has excelled academically and given service to the University and community.

Honored by his colleagues for the high degree of excellence he has maintained in his work through the years, Dr. Donald E. Pitzer, professor of history at ISUE, was the 1984 recipient of the Distinguished Professor award, made possible by a grant from National City Bank.

In presenting the award, Professor Mike Waitman called him "eminently qualified for this highest recognition from his colleagues because of his excellence in scholarship and in teaching." As an author and scholar, his research on communal life is respected and quoted throughout the world. He is the founder of the National Historic Communal Societies Association, on which he serves as executive director, and of the Center for Communal Studies, which has its home in the University Library. Since 1974, he has organized and directed the Historic Communal Societies conferences attended by scholars throughout the United States and several foreign countries. His publications on communal living include *American Communal Music of the 18th and 19th Centuries*, *New Harmony's First Utopians*, *New Harmony's Fourth of July Tradition*, and *Robert Owen's American Legacy*.

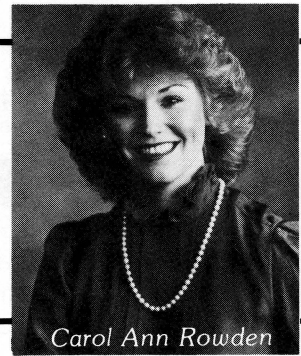

goes for a walk on his day off!"

Immediately after reading in the newspaper that the University Home would be built with private donations, Myers generously offered his time, energy and talents. Specifically, he offered to donate several pieces of fine furniture, including a powder room vanity, bathroom cabinets, and the desk. Myers, whose son attends ISUE, says, "Since ISUE serves the needs of the community so well, my wife Betty and I feel privileged to be a small part of the task this community has accepted."

Working intermittently for about ten weeks, Myers built the desk. A trip to Williamsburg, Virginia, near the time he was building the desk, influenced the early Chippendale design. He first thought he would flute the corner posts, but after the trip, he made them reeded.

Most of the difficult work on the desk was done by hand. Myers squared all the corners with a hand scraper and took about ten hours to hand carve the ISUE seal. He says the most painstaking work was carving the six drawer fronts by hand.

The man who donated the wood, A. B. Brown, is another businessman who loves working with wood and never hesitates to become involved in a community project. Former president and chairman of the board at SIGECO, Brown served on boards for the Museum, Philharmonic and Chamber of Commerce. Like Myers, his love for woodworking is the result of a relative who introduced him to the craft as a child. Today, Brown owns a woodworking shop behind his home, and although he lacks formal woodworking training, he has read many books and built several pieces of fine furniture for his own home. One piece is a beautiful secretary made of the same wood used for the president's desk.

The walnut wood Brown donated came from his own hardwood collection. He began collecting wood in 1940, looking forward to the days, after retirement, when he could pursue his interest in woodworking. This fine, air-cured lumber came in handy when an acquaintance told Brown of special plans for the University Home and its furniture. His interests in education and in woodworking made him eager to donate the walnut for the desk.
