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BLUE CROSS-BLUE SHIELD CONTRACT RENEWAL

The Indiana State University group Blue Cross-Blue Shield contract for basic hospitalization and medical benefits has been received and renewed for fiscal year 1973-74. The premium rates for Blue Cross-Blue Shield coverage will not be increased this year. The rate increase for 1972-73 combined with the prudent use of the hospitalization and medical benefits by all covered University staff members and their families has resulted in the maintenance of the present premium rates without any increase in cost.
