

1995 USI VOLLEYBALL OUTLOOK

"CLIMBING TO THE TOP"

The University of Southern Indiana volleyball team is looking to return to the upper division of the Great Lakes Valley Conference in 1995.

Last season, the Screaming Eagles posted their third consecutive winning season under Head Coach Kelly Boyd at 15-14 overall, but finished with a 3-6 league mark and a seventh place finish.

In 1995, USI will be led by senior outside hitter Michelle Welp (Jasper, Ind.), a 1994 All-GLVC performer. Welp led the team in hitting percentage, .267, with 259 kills (second on the team) in 738 attempts. She also led the team and ranked third in the GLVC in digs with 381 and was second on the team in blocks, averaging 1.0 per game (48 solos and 64 assists).

Also returning for her senior season is defensive specialist Tanya Broughton (Marengo, Ind.). Broughton, a three-year letter winner, was third on the team in digs with 189 and fifth in service aces with 16.

The junior class is represented by outside hitter Teresa Billings (Newburgh, Ind.) and outside/middle hitter Andrea Miller (Ft. Branch, Ind.). Miller saw action in all but one game last season, playing in 29 matches, and finished with a hitting percentage of .137 with 43 solos and 66 assists.

Five sophomores are returning for their second season. The group should improve with a year of experience.

Looking to make a real impact as a sophomore is outside/middle hitter Jamie Roth (Springfield, Ill.). Roth was second on the team in hitting percentage, .234, but let the team in kills with 274 in 771 attempts. To go along with her attacking

statistics, Roth was second on the team in assists, 364; service aces, 40; and digs, 177.

Also looking to explode as sophomores are middle hitter Rebecca Tillema (Wheatfield, Ind.), outside hitter Stephanie Shidler (Plymouth, Ind.), outside hitter Natalie Folz (Evansville, Ind.), and setter Angela Kaho (Lyons, Ind.).

Tillema led the team in blocks, averaging 1.5 per game, despite missing 13 matches with a sprained ankle, while Shidler was third on the team in hitting, .191, with 175 kills in 556 attempts.

Showing promise in 1994, Folz played in 17 matches, 43 games, and had a hitting percentage of .164 with 18 kills in 67 attempts, while Kaho appeared in 11 matches, 16 games, and had 15 assists and 14 digs.

Entering their first season with the Eagles as freshmen are setter Tai Richardson (Cayuga, Ind.) and outside hitter Anne-Marie Hourigan (Mountmellick, Ireland). Richardson, a four-time All-Conference performer, attended North Vermillion High School in Cayuga, Ind. Hourigan, who attended high school at Moutmellick Community School in Ireland, crossed the Atlantic Ocean to attend USI last year, but did not play volleyball.



HEAD COACH KELLY BOYD

Kelly Boyd begins her fourth season as head volleyball coach at the University of Southern Indiana.

In 1994 Boyd completed her third straight winning season with the Eagles. She led the Eagles to a 15-14 overall record and a seventh place finish in the GLVC.

In 1993, Boyd led the Eagles to a 20-9 record and a 6-3 fifth-place finish in the Great Lakes Valley Conference.

Boyd became the volleyball head coach in 1992, and in that first year led the Eagles to a 14-13 mark and a 5-4 GLVC record, finishing in the upper division. During her first two seasons as volleyball coach, Boyd was an assistant coach on the women's basketball team.

While a graduate assistant coach for women's basketball at Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond, Kentucky, Boyd earned her master's degree in physical education/sports administration. She is a native of Argeta, Ill., and earned her bachelor's degree in physical education in 1990 from Northeast Missouri State University, where she played varsity basketball from 1987 to 1989.

In addition to her duties as volleyball coach, Boyd teaches in the USI Physical Education Department.
