A Fine Arts Camp and a Kindergarten Camp -- two special University of Southern Indiana programs for children -- still have openings.

The Fine Arts Camp for youngsters who are entering kindergarten through sixth grades will be held July 13-17 at the University, co-sponsored by the Evansville Arts Council. The children will work in small, age-level groups to "try out" arts -- pottery, weaving, fabric dying, paper crafts, watercolor, drama, and mime. Art appreciation will be taught through hands-on activities and appearances by such area artists as Sylvia Worman, watercolor; Anita Powell, ceramics; Paula and Michael Boenigk, drama and mime; Chet Geiselman, sculpture; and the Totally New Theatre troupe. The \$125 registration fee includes lunches.

The Kindergarten Camp will be held at USI the week of July 20. Open to little ones preparing to enter kindergarten or first grade, the week will help the children prepare for or reinforce skills taught in kindergarten. Academics -- alphabet recognition, beginning sounds, and math preparedness -- will be stressed during the morning sessions; afternoons will be devoted to creativity, problem solving, art, music, and group play. The registration fee is \$100, which includes lunch.
