The Indiana State University Evansville Drama Department is presenting A Christmas Carol on December 17, 1972, at Vanderburgh Civic Auditorium at 2:00 p.m. as part of the Evansville Children's Theatre series.

The play is taken and adapted from the story by Charles Dickens by Martha B. King.

The character of Ebenezer Scrooge will be portrayed by Paul Groeninger, an Indiana State University Evansville senior. The son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward Groeninger, Groeninger has been active in various capacities with the Indiana State University Evansville drama department. He acted in the Fall 1971 production, Lion in the Winter and was student director for the Fall 1972 production, Mary Stuart.

The Cratchit family parts will be assumed by Roy Samples, freshman, as Bob Cratchit; Nancy Wick, freshman, as Mrs. Cratchit; Tom Angermeier, junior, as Peter; Sheral Stanton, sophomore, as Martha and Priscilla Wheatley, freshman, as Belinda. Seven children will be used in the production according to Clayton Crenshaw, the director of the play. The cast includes thirty-five persons.

The Indiana State University Evansville production is the first Christmas play ever presented in the Evansville Children's Theatre series.
