The 1992 edition of *Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges* will include 10 students from the University of Southern Indiana who have been selected as national outstanding leaders.

Students are selected by campus nominating committees and directory editors on the basis of academic achievement, service to the community, leadership in extracurricular activities, and potential for continued success.
