Robert L. Koch II, president and director of George Koch Sons, Inc., will be the fall Executive-in-Residence at the University of Southern Indiana in a program sponsored by the USI Division of Business.

Mr. Koch will lead discussion sessions at 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. and speak at a noon luncheon on Friday, November 20. The program will be held at the University Center and is open to the public. The Executive-in-Residence program is designed to stimulate students' thinking and to broaden their education through discussions and interaction with leaders in business, industry, and government.

Koch brings expertise from all three to the fall program. He has been active in the family business since he was graduated cum laude in mechanical engineering from the University of Notre Dame. He also earned an M.B.A. at the University of Pittsburgh in 1962 and in 1971, received the Professional Engineers Registration Certificate for Indiana.

His business directorships include CNB Bancshares, Southern Indiana Gas and Electric Company, Gibbs Die Casting Aluminum Corporation, Brake Supply Company, International Steel Company, National Sealant and Adhesives, Inc., and Bindley Western Industries, Inc.

Koch served as Evansville city controller from 1976 to 1980 and currently is a member of Governor Robert D. Orr's Fiscal Policy Advisory Council and the Indiana State Energy Committee. His current civic and community activities also include being a director on the Metropolitan Evansville and Indiana State Chambers of Commerce, WNIN public television and radio, the Catholic and Public Education foundations, the Evansville Museum of Arts and Science, and the University of Evansville Board of Trustees.
