Evansville will have their third annual card party in the Forum Room on the campus on April 11, 1973, at 7:30 p.m. The secretarial organization, composed of full-time ISUE secretaries, will donate card party proceeds to the club's scholarship program. Giving a scholarship award each year to an ISUE secretarial student is one of the primary functions of the organization. Entertainment is going to be by the ISUE Mid-America Singers.

The Mid-America Singers of ISUE specialize in colorful show tunes, popular songs and energetic choreography. The performers were first formed in Fall 1969, with eight singers and one accompanist. The talented group now includes fifteen performers and three accompanists. Frequent performers on local stages such as the Executive Inn and fastly becoming a state-wide renowned group, the Mid-America Singers performed for the 1973 Indiana General Assembly in February. On March 14 the Mid-America Singers presented an evening for area high school students during which the Singers performed such all-time favorites as "Old Fashioned Love Song," "When I'm Sixty-Four," "Joy to the World," and "Applause". Two of the Singers, Richard Fein and Daryl Hazel, have been accepted as singers in Opryland, Nashville, Tennessee, for the 1973 summer season. This is the first year the amusement park has auditioned singers from outside the Nashville area and Fein and Hazel are the only students from Indiana to be accepted.
