



**POLLUTION EDUCATION UPDATE.** The Office of Continuing Education will conduct a community outreach program entitled "Pollution Education Update" beginning in February and running through July. The project is designed to educate the public about pollution problems and alternative solutions. Because of the rapid industrial and population growth in Southwestern Indiana during the past

two decades, environmental problems with water, air, coal mining, and nuclear energy are a growing concern.

Three methods will be used to communicate with residents of eight Southwestern Indiana counties. At least five half-hour television programs will be broadcast on Channel 9 public television; a series of community forums will be held in Evansville and other cities; and a pollution resource guide, simplifying technical and scientific information about pollution, will be developed.

A grant in the amount of \$11,481 from the Indiana Commission for Higher Education has made this program possible. ISUE faculty members from the divisions of science and mathematics and engineering technology will act as consultants and discussion leaders. TOM ZELLER, instructor of geology and physics, will serve as technical advisor for the grant project.
