REDMAN SIGNS THREE ADDITIONAL RECRUITS

The University of Southern Indiana baseball team has added the names of two more freshmen and a junior college transfer to its fall roster. Head coach Gary Redman has announced the signing of Dave Trout, Tom Drake, and Steve Henke for the 1988-89 season.

Trout, a graduate of Mt. Vernon, Ind., led the Wildcats in at bats with 85, runs with 26, and stolen bases with 16. The infielder hit .341 in 24 games and had 23 singles, five doubles, and a home run.

Drake, a Bloomington South graduate, led the Panthers in runs scored with 33, hits with 34, doubles with nine, home runs with three, and a batting average of .472. The senior shortstop also had 13 stolen bases and 15 runs batted in.

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University of
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Henke, a Wabash Valley Junior College transfer, is a right-handed pitcher. The Aurora, Ind. native was 7-5 with a 4.36 earned run average in the spring. He is a South Dearborn graduate.

These three recruits bring the total number of recruits signed this spring to six. Blake Krueger, Tim Behme, and Tim Doyle signed earlier with the Eagles, who lost seven players from the 1988 roster to graduation.
