**ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY BACCALAUREATE
DEGREE PROGRAMS APPROVED.** The Indiana

COLLEGE PROGRAMS APPROVED: The Indiana Commission for Higher Education has approved baccalaureate degree programs in engineering technology for Indiana State University Evansville. Approval was granted at a meeting of the Commission in Indianapolis Friday, December 8.

ISUE has been offering a bachelor's degree in mining engineering technology

since approval was given for that program in 1977. With the Commission's action last week, ISUE students will now be able to receive the Bachelor of Science degree in Mining Engineering Technology or in Engineering Technology with specializations in civil engineering technology, electrical engineering technology, mechanical engineering technology, or industrial supervision.

Many of the third year courses in engineering technology have been offered this year in the mining engineering technology program. The new baccalaureate degree program will become effective in the fall semester of 1979 with students currently enrolled in engineering technology courses eligible to begin either the third or fourth year of study at that time.

President David L. Rice said the engineering technology degree programs have been developed with the advice of the Industrial Advisory Board which identified local industrial needs. "When the community leaders of Evansville studied the problems of the regional economy in the late 1950s and early 1960s, they saw the need to strengthen the scientific and manpower bases of the community as a necessary component to any regional development. These programs are in response to those needs, are in tune with current and future needs, and should have an important impact on the economy of Southwestern Indiana," he said.
