PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The University of Southern Indiana Foundation has inaugurated a new program in which students who apply at USI and are valedictorians or salutatorians in high schools commissioned by the Indiana Department of Public Instruction will be offered annual scholarships valued at \$4,500.

A total of 30 Hoosier honor students in 1988 graduating classes now have applied for admission at USI. Mary C. Fanello of 1512 Continental, Evansville, an Evansville Christian School graduate, and Lisa May of RR 3, Spencer, an Owen Valley High School graduate, are the final additions to the inaugural group of 1988 honor students offered Presidential Scholarships.

The awards are renewable for three subsequent years, for a total value of \$18,000, if the recipients remain full-time students earning at least a 3.2 cumulative grade point average (out of a possible 4.0) their freshman and sophomore years and a 3.4 GPA thereafter.
