Voter Registration Blitz at University of Southern Indiana

A three-day blitz to get University of Southern Indiana students registered to vote will be held at USI on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of this week. The goal is to register 500 students to vote in the 2004 general election.

During the blitz, USI students, employees, and alumni will register students as well as other eligible voters at tables in the Liberal Arts Center lobby, the Link in the Health Professions Center, and the University Center. The tables will be open for registration from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 4 to 6 p.m. each day of the blitz.

Jesse Southerland, a 2003 graduate of USI, designed the "Get your vote on!" logo for the USI effort, and Amy Stockholm, a USI senior is helping organize the campaign.

To be eligible to vote in the election, a person must be a U.S. citizen, 18 years of age or older by November 2, and registered to vote. October 4 is the deadline for voter registration in Indiana.
