

USI SPONSORS TRIP TO SEE PALEY COLLECTION

More than 80 paintings, sculptures, and drawings in an exhibit taken from the Paley Collection will be the feature of a mid-November weekend trip to Indianapolis, sponsored by the University of Southern Indiana Office of Continuing Education.

William Paley, late chairman of CBS, was one of the great art collectors of the 20th century. Works by Cezanne, Degas, Matisse, Picasso, Bonnard, Gauguin, and Renoir are included in the selections now on display at the Indianapolis Museum of Art.

The USI group will be accompanied by Kathryn Waters, USI professor of art who will provide background on the exhibit. They will stay at the Holiday Inn-Union Station, which has a series of Waters' paintings on display. The group will have an opportunity to visit more than 70 shops, restaurants, clubs, and special events in Union Station and other downtown Indianapolis attractions, with a visit to Conner Prairie living history museum north of the capital city rounding out the weekend.
