Screaming Eagles Varsity Club is sponsoring the annual Varsity Club Stag on September 7 at 6:00 p.m. in the Bishea Building at Burdette Park.

Guests for the evening will be the ISUE varsity basketball team, and members of the golf team and baseball team. Jerry Altstadt, head coach of the ISUE Eagles, will comment on the prospects for the 1972-73 athletic season.

This season marks the third year the young athletic department at the new university has arranged an aggressive basketball schedule. The school meets such NCAA teams as Transylvania University and University of Missouri-St. Louis. Home basketball games are played at Roberts Stadium.

Strong athletic prowess is shown in the golf team at ISUE, with such golf standouts as Jim Hamilton, the 1971 Evansville city champion, and a new addition to the team this fall, Tom Howard, a North High School graduate.

Ten victories were recorded for the baseball Eagles as the young club, under the coaching of Jim Brown, went with a 10-14 season. A strong season is planned for 1973.

The Screaming Eagles Varsity Club, now in its second year, is ISUE's official athletic booster organization. The Varsity Club was organized to unite support of athletic events on campus; to encourage young men of athletic ability to attend Indiana State University Evansville; and to establish

financial support of the athletic programs at the campus.
