## **USI "on the road" to Chicago, Memphis**

Chicago in April and Memphis in July are the 1997 road trips being sponsored by the University of Southern Indiana Office of Continuing Education, with a return to Chicago slated in November.

The April 25-27 trip to Chicago will feature Andrew Lloyd Webber's musical version of *Sunset Boulevard* at the Lyric Opera on Friday evening. John Streetman, director of the Evansville Museum, will accompany the group and provide expert commentary. April 1 is the deadline to reserve a seat on the bus. Accommodations have been arranged at the Palmer House in the Loop, in proximity to shopping and restaurants and allowing optional activities through the weekend.

The Titanic is this year's "Wonders" exhibit at the Pyramid in Memphis and features artifacts from the ill-fated ship and viewing the IMAX movie version at the Pink Palace Theater. The USI group will visit July 11-13 and stay at the Peabody Hotel.

The return trip to Chicago November 21-23 will feature a Renoir exhibit at the Art Institute, *Riverdance* at Audition Theater, and *Beauty and the Beast* at Chicago Theater.
