1. Distinguished Service Award

The Junior Chamber of Commerce Distinguished Service Award is presented annually to an outstanding young man of the community for leadership and service to community during the calendar year. Any young man, 21 through 35 years of age, is eligible for nomination.

The judging committee will be composed of distinguished citizens of the community who are now over 35. Their decision will be based on (1) Contributions to the community welfare during the year. (2) Evidence of leadership ability. (3) Evidence of personal or business progress.
