Alumni representative sought for USI Board of Trustees

The University of Southern Indiana Alumni Association is seeking applicants for alumni representative on the USI Board of Trustees to succeed Robert W. Swan, Evansville certified public accountant who is leaving the board after the July 7 trustees meeting to join the Indiana Gaming Commission.

Swan, a Princeton, Indiana, native, is a 1972 USI graduate and has been the alumni representative on the Board since 1991. He was appointed to the gaming panel last month by Governor Evan Bayh.

Nancy Johnson, director of USI Alumni Affairs, said July 15 is the deadline to apply for the replacement appointment. The alumni representative, like all members of the Board of Trustees, must be a current Indiana resident.

An alumni association screening committee will review applications and make a recommendation to Governor Bayh. For information about the post, call the alumni office, 812/464-1924.

USI will celebrate its 30th anniversary with the opening of the 1995 fall semester.
