

**INDIANA TEACHERS ATTEND
SUMMER INSTITUTE AT USI**

Twenty-nine Indiana teachers have completed their second summer institute in the University of Southern Indiana's two-year project, "Indiana and the New Nation, 1776-1876." The project, funded by a \$272,000 grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities, was designed to enrich the teachers' knowledge and understanding of American history, and strengthen the connections between the classroom and the varied historical resources in southern Indiana.

The project grant was developed by Historic Southern Indiana, an alliance of educators, economic development officials, and historic resource managers in the Ohio and lower Wabash valleys of Indiana. The final two project seminars will be held November 9-10 at New Harmony and January 25-26 in Indianapolis.

The summer institute was held July 9-27 at USI on the theme, "Community Building in Nineteenth Century Indiana, 1814-1876." Classes were conducted in New Harmony the first week, with Dr. Donald E. Pitzer, professor of history and director of the Center for Communal Studies at USI, serving as guest scholar and accompanying the teachers on visits to historic properties in the town. On the weekend, the teachers visited Madison, Indiana, for a tour of historic sites and an Ohio River cruise aboard the "River Queen."

During the second week, Dr. James Madison of Indiana University was guest scholar as the teachers visited the Lincoln Boyhood National Memorial and the German communities of Jasper, St. Meinrad, and Ferdinand. Dr. Carol Blum, an expert on social history in the Ohio Valley, conducted sessions the third week when the teachers toured areas of interest in Evansville.

Dr. John Patrick, director of the Social Studies Development Center at IU, and Evelyn Sayers of the Indiana Department of Education met with the teachers on the final day to evaluate the program and discuss ways to change teacher training and school curriculum to reflect Indiana's history.
