## **USI THEATRE TO PRESENT *NORTH SHORE FISH***

*North Shore Fish*, a poignant drama detailing the plight of women who work in a fish-packing plant, will be presented February 18-28 at USI Theatre on Igleheart Avenue.

Israel Horovitz, one of America's master contemporary playwrights, has told the story of a plant on the verge of closing, doomed by foreign competition and foolish business practices. The play concerns itself with the exploitation of women who make up the main work force, as Horovitz's portrayal of the downward direction of their lives and their victimization by larger forces produces an emotionally powerful play.

Elliot H. Wasserman, assistant professor of theatre, will direct *North Shore Fish*, with USI students making up the nine-member cast, headed by USI Theatre veterans Randy Murray, Jack Jones, and Christina Ulrich.

*North Shore Fish* will be presented at 8 p.m. Thursday-Saturday, February 18-20 and 25-27, and 2 p.m. Sunday, February 28. Tickets are \$7 for general admission, \$5 for the USI family and senior citizens.
