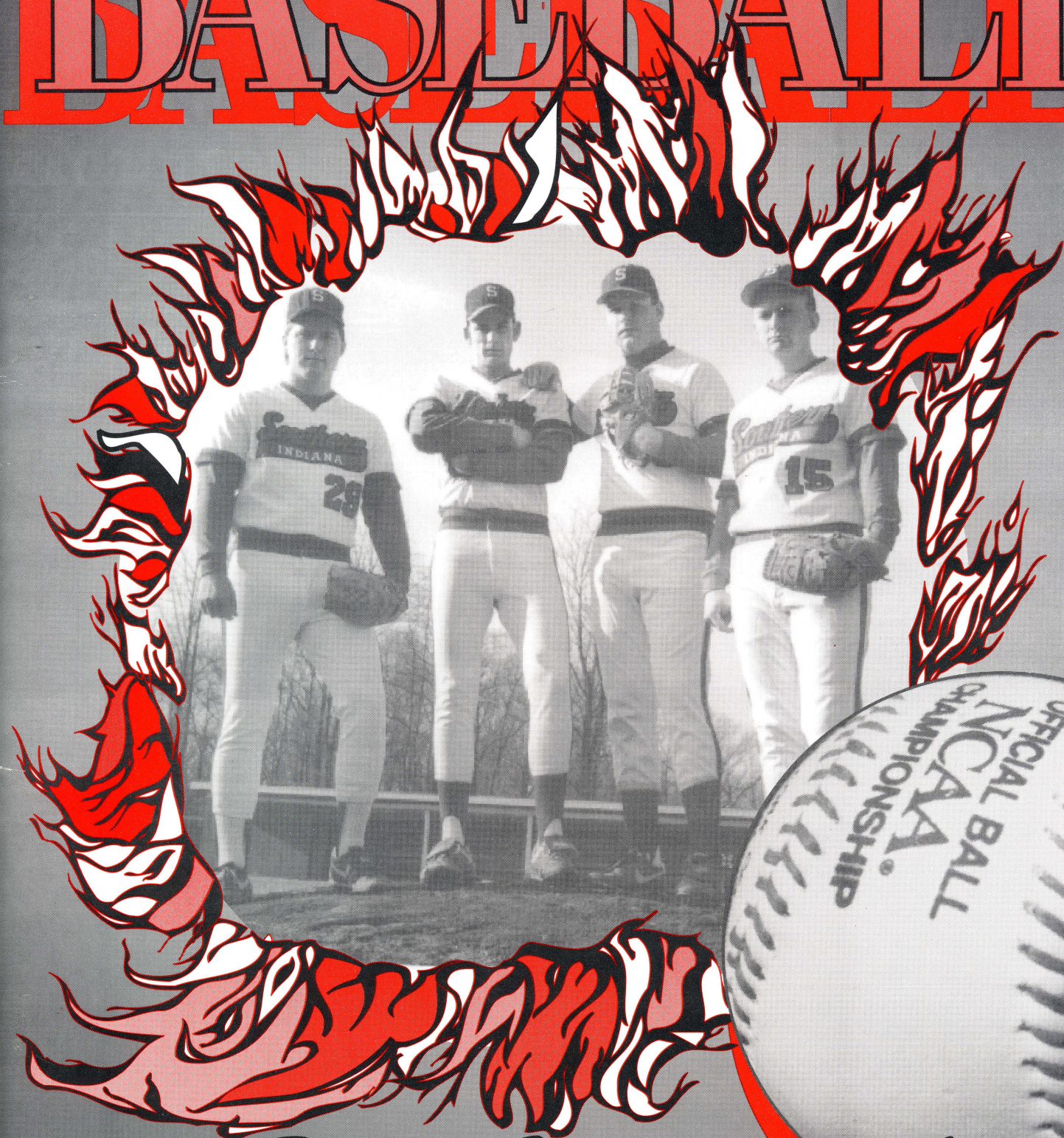

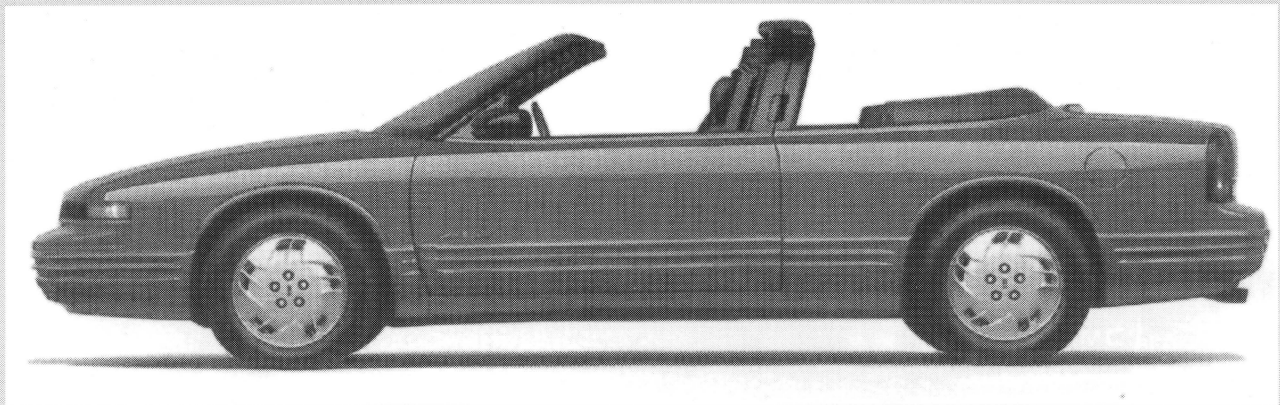

## HEAD COACH GARY REDMAN

As Gary Redman begins his fifth season at the helm of the Screaming Eagles baseball team, he will be striving to take his team to the NCAA Division II playoffs for the second time.

Redman has a 110-89-2 record at USI and is 271-190-2 over his 15 years of coaching baseball. His teams over the past ten years have a combined batting average of .302 (3399/11237).

He graduated from USI in 1975, with a bachelor's degree, majoring in mathematics and minoring in physical education. While a student, Redman produced the 15th highest batting average for a single season in the school's history.

Redman was formerly head baseball coach at Northeast Dubois High School, in Dubois, Ind., for eight years, winning the Blue Chip Conference in 1981 and 1987; having state-ranked teams in 1984 (13th) and in 1987 (6th); and being named Regional Coach of the Year in 1984 and 1987.

Baseball was not Redman's only sport at Dubois. He also was varsity basketball assistant coach for two years, head tennis coach, freshman basketball coach for a year, and eighth grade basketball coach for five years. The 36-year-old coach is also active in assisting many community baseball leagues. He has organized summer camps for younger players for the past 13 years.

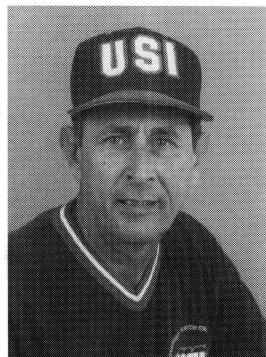
