The annual Classical Heritage Day and Tri-State Business Students Conference will be held Friday, March 12, at the University of Southern Indiana, as USI faculty invited Tri-State high school students to campus programs while USI students enjoy Spring Break.

Some 200 to 250 students from high school honors clubs and history, literature, and Latin classes are expected to attend the 16th annual Classical Heritage Day, to be held from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. in Forum I. The "Tragic Stage of Euripides" will be the theme. Dr. Daniel C. Scavone, professor of history and coordinator of the program, and Dr. Douglas K. The third annual Tri-State Business Students Conference will be held at 8 a.m. in the Physical Activities Center, with up to 600 high school students expected to attend. The program will feature re-enactment of a date-rape court trial, with Superior Court Judge William H. Miller, Evansville attorneys Charles Berger and Robert Pigman, and USI students participating. Also, USI alumni will lead information sessions on public and private accounting. The program is coordinated by Dr. Gregory P.
