COMING ATTRACTION. The Offices of Campus Ministry and Continuing Education are organizing a weekend workshop for the Fall entitled My Mother, Myself designed to explore how a woman's relationship with her mother helps form her personality.

The workshop will deal with each participants mother-daughter relationship, focusing on how a mother's feeling about herself sexually influences her daughter's sexuality.

During the 15 hour program, specific exercises will be used to augment the participant's awareness of her relationship with her mother and how that relationship influences her attitudes and behavior today.

SISTER SHEILA GRIFFIN, counselor for Campus Ministry, adds, "It is important to move away from a blaming stance toward understanding and awareness of our mother's gifts and limitations."
