A symposium for area Registered Dental Hygienists and dental hygiene students will be held on January 24, 1973 at Indiana State University Evansville from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in Room 92. The topic of the symposium is "Diagnosis and Oral Medicine for the Dental Hygienist."

Topics to be covered in the symposium are evaluation and management of patients with medical problems; the extra-oral examination; the oral examination; special diagnostic techniques; office emergencies; expanded duties for the hygienist; and government health care programs and the hygienist. The symposium will end with a clinical demonstration.
