James H. Little will represent the University of Southern Indiana in the 1988 Division II Track and Field Championships. Little, a senior at USI, has qualified to run in the 10K run to be held in San Angelo, Tex. on May 18.

The Elkhart, Ind. native qualified for the 10K in the Sea Ray Dogwood Relays held in Knoxville, Tenn. with a time of 30:29:59, one second under the required qualifying time of 30:30:00. The 10K is nothing new for Little who has run that distance in a number of road races in addition to his 74th place finish in the event during the 1987 NCAA II National Championships which USI hosted in the fall.

The race will consist of 25 laps around a circular track, a switch from the terrain of the cross country season which Little is used to.
