**Mead Johnson executives to  
speak to USI students**

Mead Johnson executives E.J. Meier, staffing manager of Human Resources, and Suzie Schrecker, director of Human Resources, will speak to USI students at 11 a.m. on Monday, November 16 in Mitchell Auditorium of the Health Professions Center on the campus. Their topic will be "Creating Career Capacity: Preparation and Communication--Keys to Success".

Meier, a 1983 USI graduate, joined Mead Johnson in January of this year. Earlier he worked in human resources at Whirlpool Corporation and owned his own business specializing in management and executive placement.

Schrecker has over 20 years of human resource management experience with Mead Johnson and Bristol Myers Squibb.
