East of 7601 Clarke Lane, Evansville, and formerly of Star Route, Leopold, is among 14 students at the University of Southern Indiana who have been chosen national outstanding campus leaders and will be included in the 1988 edition of Who's Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges.

Campus nominating committees and editors of the annual directory chose the students on the basis of their academic achievement, service to the community, leadership in extracurricular activities, and potential for continued success. The USI students join an elite group selected from more than 1,400 institutions of higher learning in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and several foreign nations.

East has been president of the Student Chapter of the American Society of Civil Engineers, vice president of the Student Government Association and Interfraternity Council, and executive vice president of Sigma Tau Gamma fraternity. He participated in the ASCE Indiana State Convention and SGA Meet the Candidates program and is a member of the Order of Omega Greek Honor Society.

East is active in intramural sports and Greek Week events on campus. In the community, he has participated in the City of Evansville's Neighborhood Revitalization Services program, Easter Seal Softball Marathon, Arthritis Foundation fund drive, and Wesselman Park Nature Center.
