INCREASE IN BLUE CROSS-BLUE SHIELD INSURANCE RATES. Blue Cross-Blue Shield premium rates will be increased as a result of higher medical care costs and increased utilization of the program by covered University employees and their families. Staff members will continue to pay 25 percent of the cost, and the University will contribute 75 percent of the cost. The old and new employees' share of the monthly premium cost is as follows:



TELEPHONE TIP FOR THE WEEK



The Dimension feature "Call Hold" makes it possible to put a first party on hold so that a second party can be reached. To hold a call, follow these easy steps:

- 1) Ask the first party to hold
- 2) Depress the switchhook
- 3) When recall dial tone is received, dial code 54 (First party is now "on hold".)
- 4) Dial desired number to reach second party

To return to the original conversation, just hang up the receiver. The telephone will ring and the first party will be on the line.
