USI Super Summer classes on campus
July 22 - July 26

Children from the ages of 3 1/2 through the young teen years will be participating in the Super Summer program at USI the week of July 22 through July 26. Fifteen classes that range from magic and food preparation to introduction to Japanese culture, adventures in art, and computer classes will be offered during the one week session.

A sampling of the courses follows.

It's Magic explores the scientific basis for magical illusions. Activities will include experiments, optical illusions, brainteasers, and a magic show for parents starring the students on Friday, July 26 at 10:30 a.m. The class runs 9 - 11:30 a.m., UC 352.

The Cafe Crew will cover selection of nutritious foods, following simple recipes, cooking dishes from a variety of cultures, and serving food in an aesthetically pleasing way considering table setting and centerpieces, 9 - 11:30 a.m., UC 351.

Students in **Design Your Own Home Page** will create an individual home page and learn how to install it on the Internet's World Wide Web, 9 - 11:30 a.m., OC 3074.

Japanese instructor Izume Mochizuki Greubel will offer students a **Welcome to Japan** in a course that will teach Japanese culture and customs through a variety of language, art, and hands-on activities, 12:30-3 p.m., UC 353.

Preschoolers will **Reach for the Stars** in this aerospace education program. Activities include mapping moon faces, making gliders, and eating "space food," 9 - 11:30 a.m., L 100.
