If the youngsters are starting to get bored and restless in their summer vacations, the University of Southern Indiana's Super Summer and Enrichment programs may be just what they need.

Two weeks remain in Super Summer -- July 7 at Evansville Day School and July 14 at USI -- and offer the following choices (grade or age levels in parentheses):

Day School/mornings: Experience Kindergarten (K-1); Stretching Stories (1-3); Choir School (2-4); Wonder Science (2-4); Nature Crafts (3-6); summer science (4-6); Computer Graphics (4-7); Study Skills (5-8)

Day School/afternoons: Dinosaurs (4-6); Math & More (K-1); I Like Me (2-3); Adventures in Arts (2-4); Tops & Yoyos (4-7); Painting (5-8); Babysitting Club (5-8)

USI/mornings: Oceanography (ages 4-6); Dabble in the Arts (K-1); All Aboard (1-3); Wonder Science (3-5); Nature Crafts (4-7); Structures (4-7); Design Your Own Web Page (6-8)

USI/afternoons: Book-based Snacks & Crafts (ages 5-6); Hands-on Science (1-3); Adventures in Art (2-4); Kids in the Kitchen (3-5); Beginning Sign Language (4-7); Computer Applications (6-8)

The remaining summer enrichment courses open to older youth include Portrait Drawing (ages 11-16), July 14-18; high school study skills (grades 9-11), three sessions starting August 1; and SAT preparation (grades 9-12), verbal-July 19 and math-July 26. All sessions are at USI.
